Today's topic: "GOD IS OMNIPRESENT"

DEVELOPMENT OF THE CLASS





Make a short prayer with your child / children, related to today's topic. Remember to use a simple language, easy to understand.

Sample of prayer:

Lord Jesus, we thank you for this day and for giving us the opportunity to learn from your Word, we ask you that every day we can understand that you are the creator of this whole world and that everything you do is good and perfect; that we always remember what we learn from you and we can practice it in our life always doing your will. Amen.

Biblical history

Ask them to open their Bible to the Book of Daniel in chapter 3, and read the important verses (You can assign the verses to read)

- Nebuchadnezzar erects a statue (v. 1)
- Nebuchadnezzar dedicates the statue (v. 3)
- The town crier reads the king's decree (v. 4-6)
- Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-nego are accused of not obeying the king's order (v. 12)





- Shadrach, Meshach, Abed-nego defend their FAITH (v. 14-17)
- The king gives the order to throw them into the oven 7 times heated fire (v.19)
- Nebuchadnezzar sees four men in the oven (v.25)
- They leave the oven without any burn (v.27)

Tell the story as dynamic as possible or dramatize it based on the age and understanding of the children. Explain to them that God is in everywhere and was with Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego even though it seemed not.







Below, you will find the information you should know about today's class:

Key verse: Proverbs 15: 3 "The Eyes of the Lord are everywhere, watching over the good and the bad."

LOOK WITH YOUR CHILDREN FOR THIS VERSE IN THE BIBLE, READ IT SEVERAL TIMES, AND IF POSSIBLE MEMORIZE IT.

Today we are going to learn about our Omnipresent God, this means that He is present everywhere, for which He is immense, there is no place where He is not. It fully embraces all of creation, as a perfect and supreme being, as a personal God, in all His attributes.

IMPLICATIONS OF THE OMNIPRESENCE OF GOD.

- It is the fear of the Sinner: God sees the sinner; he cannot hide even under the stones. God not only sees the actions, but the thoughts of the human being. But at the same time His Omnipresence is good news, because it means that He is always there with you, as a just and forgiving God, God of all mercy, of grace and of all goodness. Prov. 15: 3
- It leads us to fear Him: God affirms that all the time we live before His presence, no matter where we are, He is all the time seeing who trembles before His Word, the humble of heart. Isaiah 66: 1-2
- It leads us to Trust: One of the things that brings the most comfort to our hearts is understanding that God is near. We should never doubt that. He is with us, present all the time. Jesus said it: I will be with you, every day, until the end of the world. How can He keep that promise? because he is omnipresent God. 2 Chronicles 16: 9

When we are in a situation at night or even at school, we can feel that we are alone but God is with us to help us. No matter where we are, we can pray to God.

Allow the children to name places they have visited and ask them if God can hear their prayers there, just as he heard the prayer in the story of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-nego mentioned in chapter 3 of the book of Daniel. Even when we are in a situation where no one can help us, God is with us to help us.

These young men knew that God was with them at all times and that by honoring Him He would help them.
