




WE BELIVE THAT JESUS IS GOD BY THE TESTIMONY **OF HIS WORD**

MAIN OBJECTIVE: That the child learns to build a true communion with God by discovering what he demands of his children through the 1st Epistle of John

DEVELOPMENT OF THE CLASS





Make a short prayer with your child / children, related to today's topic. Remember to use a simple language, easy to understand.

Below, you will find the information you should know about today's class:

Key verse: 1 John 5:5 Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

LOOK WITH YOUR CHILDREN FOR THIS VERSE IN THE BIBLE, READ IT SEVERAL TIMES, AND IF POSSIBLE, MEMORIZE IT.

Next, you will find the information you should know about today's class:

In the month of April of this year we interrupted this series of the letter of 1 John, let us remember that in the last classes of this series we saw that the true children of God do not love the world, nor the things that are in the world, but that they seek to do the will of God. The question arises, how to beat the world? the answer is given by John by emphasizing that we overcome the world with our faith in the Bible's testimony that Jesus is God (1 John 5: 5).

John gives us THREE testimonies that confirm that Jesus is God and that he came in the flesh to die for our sins on the cross, these testimonies are THE WATER, THE BLOOD and THE SPIRIT.





I. THE TESTIMONY OF WATER.

The first witness is the water of the Jordan, with which Jesus was baptized. The water bears witness to what he saw at the baptism of Jesus: after John the Baptist baptized Jesus, when he came up out of the water, those same waters witnessed how heaven was opened and the voice of the Father said "... this is my beloved Son; I am very pleased with him." Matthew 3:17 "The water also witnessed how the Spirit of God descended on Jesus in the form of a dove". **See Annex I for related activity**.

II. THE TESTIMONY OF THE BLOOD

The second witness is the blood of Jesus shed on the cross. The blood testifies to having been shed on the scourges, then with the crown of thorns, and finally on the cross, when Jesus shed his last drop and died. The blood of Jesus is a faithful and true witness that Jesus died and that he is God. **See Annex II for related activity.**

When they thrust the spear into Jesus' side and blood and water came out, the Roman soldiers, experts in this kind of execution, knew that he was dead. I have even one of them, upon seeing what happened, exclaimed: "When the centurion and those who were guarding Jesus with him saw the earthquake and everything that had happened, they were terrified and exclaimed: Truly this was the Son of God! Matthew 27:54.


III. THE TESTIMONY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

Your third witness is the Holy Spirit, who is God, the Spirit of Truth who cannot lie. He testifies that Jesus is the Son of God since He, the Father and Jesus are inseparable, indivisible, eternally united without confusion or mixture. You have been with Him from eternity past, in creation, in His incarnation, life, work, death and resurrection and they will be together for eternity. And that conviction is what he puts in the hearts of all those who believe in Jesus. **See Annex III for related activity.**





IV. APPLICATION







Check if your child has learned 🖔

Ask your child orally or in writing:

- Do you remember which are the 3 witnesses that Juan presents to us? The water, the blood, and the Holy Spirit
- Can you say that it is confirmed by the testimonies of the water, the blood, and the Holy Spirit? That Jesus is God
- Can you remember the key verse?

Optional activity for children of 7 and 8 years old: With a page of bond paper create an accordion with the three largest testimonies that prove that Jesus is God you can draw and put a short explanation. You can use the introductory videos on the subject.

Make the following craft (you can use foamy, cardboard or paper) or draw the Bible for your child to explain in his words why Christians should read the Bible explain to him that we must do it so as not to doubt it and so that we know how we should live


