Introduction Activity 💡

For this activity you will have to work together with your child. Plan to plant a plant together in the garden so that your child can watch the plant grow. Bible teaching

Below, you will find the information you should know about today's class:

Key verse: **Hebrews 10:32-34** ³² Remember those earlier days after you had received the light, when you endured in a great conflict full of suffering. ³³ Sometimes you were publicly exposed to insult and persecution; at other times you stood side by side with those who were so treated. ³⁴ You suffered along with those in prison and joyfully accepted the confiscation of your property, because you knew that you yourselves had better and lasting possessions.

LOOK WITH YOUR CHILDREN FOR THIS VERSE IN THE BIBLE, READ IT SEVERAL TIMES, AND IF POSSIBLE MEMORIZE IT.

Next, you will find the information you should know about today's class:

We will learn that although God is spirit and we cannot see Him, the Bible tells us about Jesus that He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. Colossians 1:15. Therefore our faith in Christ in any circumstance is extremely important for our Christian life, even in moments of suffering, because we know that He will return.

I. FAITH IN THE GOSPEL IN THE MIDST OF SUFFERING.

The author of Hebrews writes this letter to the first Jewish Christians who were dispersed by persecution and faced suffering. The author leads them to remember their past days, which would lead us to suppose that in those days they enjoyed a certain peace, but they began to suffer persecution after being enlightened by the gospel and, as mentioned in the passage, they had a “great struggle of suffering”.

We must understand that, as Christians, just as we have suffered these last months and years ago, we will continue to face many difficulties; and that the more we seek to obey the gospel, the more difficulties we will face. Sufferings are inherent in the life of the Christian. The more we obey the Word, the more the world will reject us.

II. THE GOOD WORK OF THE CHRISTIAN IN THE MIDST OF THE CRISIS.

In the midst of all the suffering they experienced, upon receiving the gospel they acted according to what the word of God asks:

- They showed solidarity with all those who suffered, that is, they did not ignore the pain that their brothers felt and were united in those difficult times.
- They were compassionate to all those who were in jail, because of the persecution, they visited them and provided what was necessary for their families.
- Their property was taken from them by force and probably with violence, but they took it with an attitude of joy.

In the face of suffering, instead of denying their faith, they accepted it with joy. They were clear about how to respond through the gospel. Why did they have this attitude in the face of so much suffering? Because they were sure that the reward they would receive in heaven was greater than anything they could have here on earth. As Jesus taught in Matthew 5:12: "Rejoice and be glad, for your reward in heaven is great, for thus they persecuted the prophets who were before you."

III. LIVING A LIFE WITH FAITH IN THAT CHRIST WILL COME SOON

“Therefore, do not throw away your confidence, which has great reward. 36 For you need patience, so that when you have done the will of God, you may obtain the promise.” (Hebrews 10: 35-36)

What is it that motivates humanity to keep going? What motivates you to face everything that will come in the future? Where is your hope for the future? What should motivate the believer to remain firm in the faith are the promises of God, that He will come a second time and that he will give reward to his children. That is, full salvation.

APPLICATION. ANSWER TO HOW TO LIVE WITH FAITH.

- a) Those of us who have received the gospel are led by the Spirit of God to put into practice all that we have learned.
- b) Show companionship and compassion for your siblings.
- c) Believe in the one who will come to fulfill the promise, and who can fulfill it because he is God: Jesus.
- d) The only way to live with confidence in the face of so much uncertainty is in Christ Jesus.
