Introduction Activity

Ask your children how their actions have been in the midst of the situations we are experiencing, if they have been afraid in the midst of this COVID19 pandemic, and what they would say to their friends who may feel the same. Would he tell them about God? What would he do if he saw one of his friends making fun of others, even him for being a Christian? He can give you examples and you must listen and you must teach him that at all times we must seek God's faithful word, no matter what situations we go through.

Key verse: **2 Timothy 3:14-15** “¹⁴ But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it, ¹⁵ and how from infancy you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.”

WHY WE SHOULD ALWAYS SEEK THE WORD OF GOD?

I. BECAUSE THE DAYS BEFORE CHRIST'S SECOND COMING ARE TOUGH.

2 Timothy 3: 1: “Now, keep in mind that in the last days difficult times will come” (NIV) When the Bible speaks of the last days or the last times (according to the author), it refers to the period that we are living, between the first and second coming of Jesus.

The Bible shows us that as time passes, more and more people will do what they want and not what the word of God says. Paul in his letter to Timothy shows it as follows: **2 Timothy 3: 2-3:** “² People will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boastful, proud, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, ³ without love, unforgiving, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not lovers of the good” (NIV)

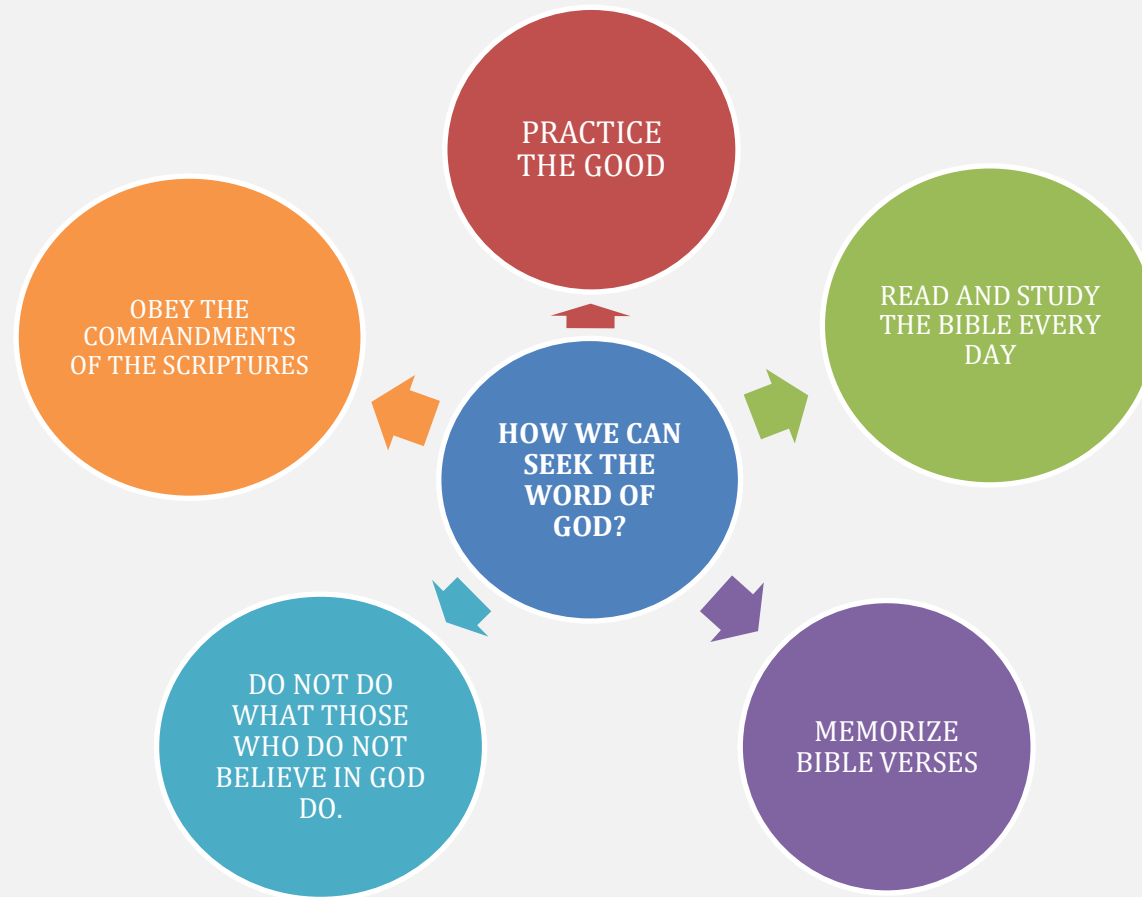
Let's take one of Paul's examples of what people who do not know God and his word do: disobedient to parents, parents are authority established by God, that is why children must obey and respect them, but we see how today It is increasingly normal not to obey the authorities and we also see how disrespect for authority is celebrated, in families, at work, in the streets (with the police), etc.

II. BECAUSE ONLY THE BIBLE CAN GIVE YOU WHAT YOU NEED TO LIVE FOREVER WITH CHRIST.

2 Timothy 3:14-15 “¹⁴ But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it, ¹⁵ and how from infancy you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.”

Paul teaches us that unlike the evil men who will be more and more, we must always seek the Word, always believe in what the Bible says, seek in it what you should do, how you should behave at all times and in all places. : at home, at your school, with your friends, etc .; only the Bible can teach you what to do when there are problems and show you what is right or wrong; It will also teach you to do good. It is not just about reading it, you must love it, understand it, study it and live it.

7 Final Prayer

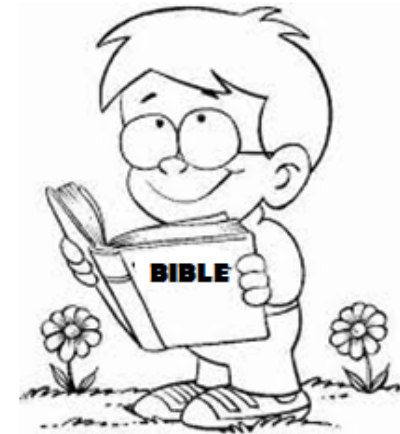
Make a short prayer with your children to end the class, thanking God for what they have learned and asking him that we can practice this every day.
