



“THE SUPERIORITY OF JESUS CHRIST”

MAIN OBJECTIVE: that the child understands the superiority of Jesus Christ above all things while studying what the author of Hebrews tells us in chapter one.

DEVELOPMENT OF THE CLASS

1

Initial Prayer

Make a short prayer with your child / children, related to today's topic. Remember to use a simple language, easy to understand.

Sample of prayer: Lord Jesus, we thank you for this day and for giving us the opportunity to learn from your Word, we ask you that every day we can understand that you are the creator of this whole world and that everything you do is good and perfect; that we can recognize that you are superior to all created things; let us trust that you are in control of our lives and that we always remember what we learn from you and we can practice it in our life always doing your will. Amen.

Introduction Activity

Ask your son what superhero he admires and ask him what powers does he have? What does he do? Does he always win? Does he rescue people in trouble? When he has finished telling you everything, you must show him that superheroes are only seen in movies, but that we have a Hero, superior to all the fiction we see in movies, superior to the wind, superior to the sea (remember when He opened the Red Sea), superior to diseases, to the same death He defeated, is superior to anything else created on this earth. He does not need a superpower to save us, he died on a cross and now he cares for us. His name is Jesus Christ.

At the end you will find an image with super heroes that you can print or show your child to do this activity.

Below, you will find the information you should know about today's class:

Key verse: **Hebrews 1:1-4:** "God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways, ² in these last days has spoken to us in *His* Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom He also made the world. ³ And He is the radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature, and upholds all things by the word of His power. When He had made purification of sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, ⁴ having become so much better than the angels, to the extent that He has inherited a more excellent name than they.

LOOK WITH YOUR CHILDREN FOR THIS VERSE IN THE BIBLE, READ IT SEVERAL TIMES, AND IF POSSIBLE, MEMORIZE IT.

Next, you will find the information you should know about today's class:

JESUS is superior to all things. The author of Hebrews gives us 5 reasons why we must have confidence that Jesus is superior even to the circumstances that we may be living and that should make us trust him.

JESUS is superior to everything because ...

I. JESUS CHRIST IS OWNER AND CREATOR OF ALL THINGS AND MADE THE UNIVERSE

The first reason why Christ is superior is that EVERYTHING in the universe belongs to Him. We are also told that only He has the power to create. Jesus Christ is the Creator of everything that exists, because He is God. Everything exists and was created by Him, in Him and for Him. If God has given everything to Christ, it also means that you belong to Him; you belong to no one but the Lord's. He created you and he did it with a purpose: so that you give him glory (love him with all your heart and obey his commandments; make him the most important thing in your life) with your life and family.

II. JESUS CHRIST IS THE BRIGHTNESS AND IMAGE OF GOD

The Glory of God is invisible to us but we can see it in CHRIST, through the works he did. Jesus reflects the Glory of God; He enlightens us through His Word (the Bible).

III. JESUS CHRIST IS THE ONE WHO SUPPORTS AND MAINTAINS ALL THINGS WITH THE WORD OF HIS POWER.

When He said "let it be" everything came true, everything was made through His word. Jesus Christ with the power of his word made the leprosy disappear just by saying "BE CLEANED"; and ordered the storm and the winds to disappear and thus they instantly disappeared. Only the words of Christ really have the power to create and sustain everything.

IV. JESUS CHRIST IS THE ONE WHO CLEANSSES OUR SINS

Only Jesus could cleanse our sins. The Creator and Sustainer is also the redeemer. He is the only means of salvation for man. The greatness of Christ is that he cleansed our sins on his own, dying for us on the cross and did not need anyone else, this is called **REDEMPTION**.

V. JESUS CHRIST IS SUPERIOR THAN ANGELS AND HAS AN EXCELLENT NAME.

If Jesus is the Creator of everything, he also created the angels that is why he is superior to them because they are created beings, whereas Christ was not created. Jesus is superior because angels cannot give us salvation, only in Jesus is there salvation.

Check if your child has learned

6 to 8 years: Ask your child orally or in writing:

- What did you learn today?
- Who is superior to all things?
- Why should we trust God in these difficult days? Explain it with your words
- Can you remember the key verse?

Aplication

Explain to your child that sometimes we can feel restless or scared by the circumstances that happen around us, such as illness, wind, rain, family problems, etc. But we must remember that Jesus is the creator of all things and it is he who sustains our lives. We must remember that Jesus gave us the most important thing, our salvation, and he did it through his death on the cross, shedding his blood for us. Tell your child that the next time he feels fearful about circumstances; remember that Jesus is in control of his life because He is superior to all things. **Do the activity in ANNEX 2**

Memorize: Hebrews 1: 4 made so much superior to the angels, as he inherited an excellent name than they.

Final Prayer

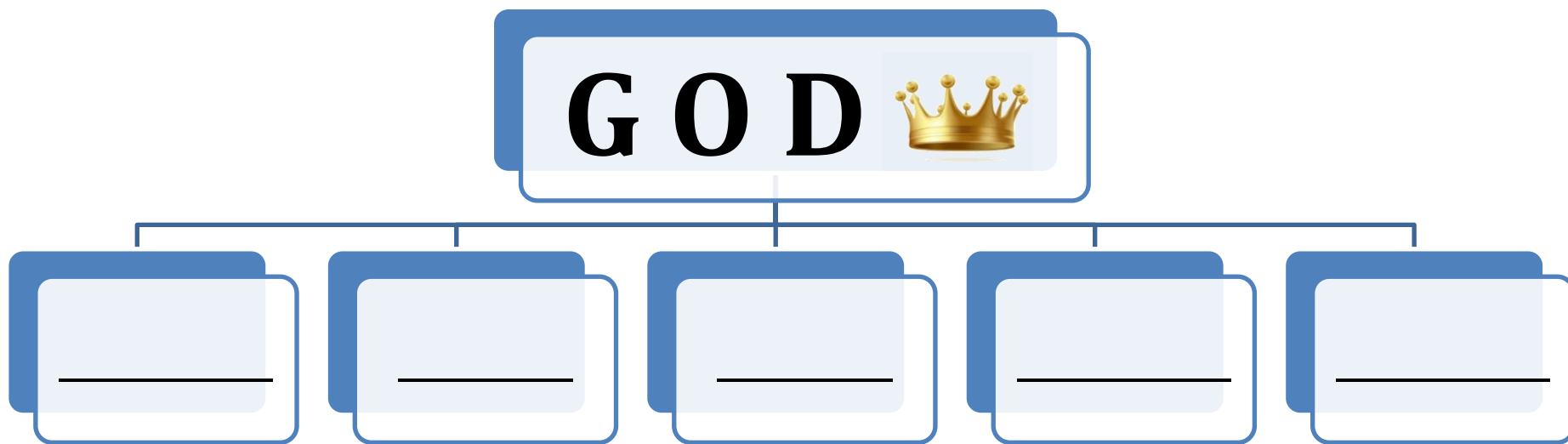
Make a short prayer with your children to end the class, thanking God for what they have learned and asking him that we can practice this every day.
