DEVELOPMENT OF THE CLASS



Initial Prayer 👃

Make a short prayer with your child / children, related to today's topic. Remember to use a simple language, easy to understand.

Sample of prayer: Lord Jesus, we thank you for this day, because once again, you show us your immense love, because you fill us with mercy every morning, we know that your powerful hand does not let go of us, thank you because only in your word we find the true wisdom that we need to be guided to Glorify your Name at all times, let our gaze be fixed only on you because only in you we find eternal life, bless each of our homes and the Church, in the name of Jesus. Amen.

3 Introduction Activity 🖓

Tell your child to think for a moment about how he solves math problems when he is given an assignment. Ask him, what do you do when you can't solve them? Now, tell him that according to mathematical books, there are some steps that could help us discover the answers and see the illustration in ANNEX 1.

Then explain to your child that as they could see in the illustration there is a way in which we can solve problems, but this type of wisdom will always end up being vanity (It does not last forever, it is temporary) although it is useful to escape from many problems, is unable to change our heart.

Key verse: Ecclesiastes 2: 15: So I said in my heart, As it happens to the fool, It also happens to me, And why was I then more wise?" Then I said in my heart, "This also *is* vanity."

LOOK WITH YOUR CHILDREN FOR THIS VERSE IN THE BIBLE, READ IT SEVERAL TIMES, AND IF POSSIBLE, MEMORIZE IT.

Next, you will find the information you should know about today's class:

This day we will learn that even with a lot of human wisdom, we cannot avoid death. As Christians we should not fear death, it is something that we cannot avoid because it happens by the will of God. For us Christians, death brings hope because we can be sure that after we die we will be with Jesus forever and we can finally see him. For people who do not believe in God, dying is the end of life, they believe that there is no eternal life with Christ and that is why they seek the wisdom of this world, for them, to have all possible wisdom, all possible things, is everything, but for those of us who believe in CHRIST, He is everything.





I. WHAT THE PREACHER UNDERSTOOD ABOUT DEATH.

Solomon continued to seek to solve his problems through things of this world, this time he asked himself a question: How to escape from what causes us pain or great sadness such as death? He sought to escape through WISDOM, that is, through the great knowledge that he had about different subjects.

He realized then that wisdom allows you to understand some things and helps you make better decisions, but it is not possible through it to avoid what we feel when someone dies.

II. THE WISDOM THAT OVERCOMES PAIN AND SADNESS.

If human wisdom is not able to rid you of pain and sadness or anger and fear that death can cause, is there anything that can? YES! PUT YOUR EYES ONLY IN CHRIST AND NOT ON THE THINGS OF THIS WORLD! It is for the wisdom that we can find in CHRIST through his Word (the Bible) that we can find joy, peace, tranquility.


Recognizing this, we see that pain turns to joy, because the wisdom we need comes from his Word.

It is therefore important to proclaim the gospel (talk to other children what we learn about Jesus), so they can also know Jesus and find true happiness, peace and joy that only comes from Him and His wisdom.





III. CONCLUSION



Repent of your sins and run to Jesus, because remember, your human wisdom is not capable of freeing you from pain and sadness or hatred, your refuge and your way is Jesus Christ.


Final Prayer 🙏
