MAIN OBJECTIVE: that the children decide to be ambassadors of Christ on earth.

DEVELOPMENT OF THE CLASS

Initial Prayer

Make a short prayer with your child / children, related to today's topic. Remember to use a simple language, easy to understand.

Sample of prayer: Lord Jesus, we thank you for this day, because you allow us to learn more from your Word. We ask you that every day we can remember that we are sinners and yet you chose us for your glory; may we always remember what we learn from you, may we recognize that we have been reconciled through your sacrifice on the cross and because you have taken us as children, we are now ambassadors of your word. Amen.

Introduction Activity

Assign your son a mission according to his age, something that he can do within the home, and that he can understand is an order and must fulfill it. You can use your creativity; you can assign him to read a biblical verse and can explain to his brothers or family what God speaks in his word. At the end of the mission, you must ask if he fully fulfilled what you entrusted to him.

What motivated him to obey you and fulfill his assigned mission? Then you must explain to your son that loving Christ should lead us to seek others to know him and love him too. We must announce everything he sends us in his Word and try to convince our family members and other people who do not know him, that he is our only savior.

Bible teaching

Key verse: **2 Corinthians 5:11** "Since, then, we know what it is to fear the Lord, we try to persuade others"

LOOK WITH YOUR CHILDREN FOR THIS VERSE IN THE BIBLE, READ IT SEVERAL TIMES, AND IF POSSIBLE, MEMORIZE IT.

Next, you will find the information you should know about today's class:

Today we will talk about being AMBASSADORS for Christ.

Do you know that he is an AMBASSADOR? An ambassador is a person who represents another person or a place like a country; For example: our country has ambassadors in many countries of the world, and they represent El Salvador and they must work hard so that others who do not know our country, know all the good that there is in it.

What does it mean then to be an AMBASSADOR OF CHRIST? It means that, as his children, we are his representatives and we act at all times as he would, fulfilling his commandments and working hard so that others can know and love him. We do this by studying his Word (the Bible) because only there we can find everything we need to know about Christ to be good AMBASSADORS.

What makes us ambassadors for Christ?

That our sins have been forgiven through the death of Jesus on the cross and we are now his children.

What makes us want to be ambassadors for Christ? THE FEAR OF THE LORD

The Bible tells us in 2 Corinthians 5:11 "Therefore, knowing the fear of the Lord, we persuade men", the word persuade means to convince.

Fearing the Lord means feeling admiration for Him, seeing his incredible power, his greatness, understanding that he is superior to everything that exists and that he is Holy. Feeling fear of God makes us obey him because we do not want to do anything that might offend him. The fear of God does not mean feeling fear, it means feeling such great respect that we will always seek to do what He asks of us through his Word (the Bible).

THE LOVE FOR CHRIST

Loving Christ should lead us to seek that others know him and love him as well. Loving Christ should lead us to live for him, doing everything he commands us in his Word and trying to convince our friends, colleagues and family that he is our only savior.

What then is our mission?

God gives us a mission: to be his AMBASSADORS and to tell everyone how good the Lord is. But being an AMBASSADOR OF CHRIST, is not only telling everyone how good the Lord is, it is also showing good behavior, being an example to others and that our way of living shows our love and fear of God. We must live remembering every day that being ambassadors, we represent Christ and all people must see Christ in us, how can they see Christ in us? Fulfilling his commandments in our life, praying, doing good, forgiving, and taking the Word of God to others.

Check if your child has learned

Ask your child orally or in writing:

Make a short prayer with your children to end the class, thanking God for what they have learned and asking him that we can practice this every day.


ANNEX 1. Make the craft with your child.
