Key verse: **Ecclesiastes 1: 1-2** Words of the Preacher, son of David, king in Jerusalem. 2 Vanity of vanities, says the Preacher, vanity of vanities, all is vanity.

LOOK WITH YOUR CHILDREN FOR THIS VERSE IN THE BIBLE, READ IT SEVERAL TIMES, AND IF POSSIBLE, MEMORIZE IT.

Next, you will find the information you should know about today's class:

1. WITHOUT CHRIST ALL IS VANITY

Ecclesiastes 1: 1-2 Words of the Preacher, son of David, king in Jerusalem. 2 Vanity of vanities, says the Preacher, vanity of vanities, all is vanity.

Do you remember what VANITY means? It is something that only lasts a moment.

In this world we are full of very valuable things, but all these things are not eternal, they last only for a moment, they end, they are ruined; they are VANITY if we give them more importance than CHRIST does. He must be the most important thing in our life because only He will be with us forever and with Him everything is forever.

2. WITHOUT JESUS CHRIST, WORK IS VANITY

Ecclesiastes 1: 3 “what profit does man receive from all the work with which he toils under the sun?”

Whatever work you want to do when you grow up, it will be vanity, that is, it will be of no use if you do not do it to glorify Christ. If you work for Christ, you can earn a reward in heaven and enjoy your work.

3. WITHOUT CHRIST WISDOM IS VANITY

Ecclesiastes 1:18 “because in much wisdom there is much anguish, and whoever increases knowledge increases pain.”

Do you remember what WISDOM is? Wisdom is all the knowledge that a person can have on different topics.

1- Even if you spend your whole life learning, you will not be able to know everything that happens in the universe.

2- Even with all the wisdom in the world, you cannot change the things that God said cannot be changed.

Seeking the wisdom of the world will cause us much pain and anguish. Instead, wisdom in Christ will give us peace and joy.

This wisdom is only found in THE BIBLE.

4. WITHOUT CHRIST, JOY IS VANITY

Ecclesiastes 2: 1 “I said to myself, ‘Come now, I will make a test of pleasure; enjoy yourself.’ But again, this also was vanity”.

Remember that:

- Have fun with your friends
- Eat what you like best
- Have the best toys, clothes or shoes
- Live in the most beautiful house

All this can bring you joy, but only for a while, then your heart will feel that it is not enough and you will want more and you will NOT be able to enjoy all those things because only in Christ can we enjoy our toys, our food, our house, our friends. Even though we do not deserve anything because of our sin, He in His goodness has given us everything we have. Joy or happiness comes from Christ, not from the things of this world.

5 Check if your child has learned

6 years:

Ask your child to answer the following questions:

1. Do you remember the topics you have studied?
2. What does VANITY mean?
3. How is life without CHRIST?
4. Is our joy in everything we have?
5. For whom should we do our work?

7 and 8 years:

Ask your child to find the answers to the questions in the alphabet soup in ANNEX 1. If he still cannot read / write, you can help him or ask him to answer the questions orally.

6 Application

Take some time with your child and talk about:

WHAT THINGS HAVE BEEN VALUABLE TO HIM, then remind him that there is nothing more valuable than Christ.

WHAT HAVE YOU WORKED HARD FOR IN KINDERGARTEN, SCHOOL / COLLEGE? then remind him that he must work hard to glorify Christ.

WHAT THINGS HAVE YOU WORRIED ABOUT TO LEARN (how to win in a video game, a trendy song, etc.), then remind her of the wisdom she must seek is that of Christ.

WHAT THINGS GIVE HIM JOY OR MAKE HAPPY, then remind him that all things in the world give us momentary joy, and that our true joy only comes from CHRIST.

OPTIONAL ACTIVITY: print ANNEX 2 and ask your child to stick colored paper, beans, pasta on the letters, or to color or decorate them with whatever they prefer.

7 Final Prayer

Make a short prayer with your children to end the class, thanking God for what they have learned and asking him that we can practice this every day.
